1. Eligibility of Athletes, Weight and Age Categories

Seniors

Age limit: Minimum Age 17 years (2009)

Categories of Men: -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, -120kg +120kg Categories of Women: -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, -78kg, -87kg, +87kg.

Men: 4 minutes
Women: 3 minutes

Each Nation can enter maximum 1 player in each weight category.

All players must be citizens of the country they represent in order to compete.

The players representing only National Kurash Federations – Official members of the IKA can compete at World championship.

Each nation can enter maximum 2 Referee with International 3 star (accommodation-double occupancy and meals will be covered by IKA).

2. Competition System

Elimination system (knock out), if 5 or fewer players in one weight category Round Robin system will apply.

3. Competition Rules

The championships will be governed by the International Kurash Association rules (E.O.R). The English language version of the rules is available at the IKA official site www.kurashika.org

- 1. Please note under new rules approved in 2017 any player without standard Yakhtak will be automatically disqualified once on the Gilam.
- 2. Due to the rules and regulations of the Islamic Republic of Iran it is compulsory to wear Hijab for ladies during the competition period.

4. Referees

Referee Exam:

The Referee exams quota MAX 4 candidates Per Country for 2 candidates in 2 star and 2 candidates in 3-star, MAX 4 candidates per country (Host country may enter total of 6 examinees). English Language Needed!

After online registration and checking the candidate's experience, IKA TD will send a confirmation.

Exam costs: USD 250 (USD) for 2 star and USD 400 (USD) for 3 stars. All Participants must cover all their costs.

Referee exams are taken during the championship.

5. Registration

A) Athletes

IKA affiliated National Federations can send **1 athlete** in each weight category who is already registered in the IKA system.

B) Congress Delegates: Congress Delegates shall register through the IKA Online Registration System, completing the required forms. (Maximum two delegates can attend the IKA congress)

6. Requirements

All athletes must bring to the official Weigh-In the following documents:

- Passport or
- Accreditation Card with valid photo.

7. Athletes' Uniform

All players must bring and use their IKA-approved and standard Kurash uniform – Yakhtak (blue and green). Please note under new rules approved in 2017 any player without standard Yakhtak will be automatically disqualified once on the Gilam.

8. Transportation

- Airport Reception:
- All participants will be expected to arrive at Mashhad International Airport (MHD).
- The official arrival airport is Mashhad International Airport (MHD). The following airlines operate to Mashhad (Fly Dubai, Air Arabia, Turkish Airlines, Qatar Airways, Kuwait Airways)
- From Mashhad International Airport to Bojnourd by car or by bus, for Border crossing please contact to Iran Kurash Association
- Border Reception
- There will be a welcome desk to guide all teams at the points of arrival and departure.
- The LOC will provide local transportation between the Hotel, Competition Venue and Training Venue(s) during the Championships Period.
- The LOC will also provide pick up and drop off at the airport / or up-to-border point.
- Please note that the pickup is only available Mashhad International Airport (MHD)

B) The IKA and the OC will cover accommodation, 3-time meals, local transport FREE for 2 representatives per delegation double occupancy.

C) Payment of Hotel Room Charges:

• All delegations must pay the full room charges at the time of registration in CASH and USD\$ up on arrival, as the Organizing Committee will not be able to accept any other form of payment

- Delegations will not be allowed to receive accreditations and hotel room keys if they do not first clear the payment of full hotel room charges.
- D. Check-In and Check-Out:
- The room rates provided for the Event only apply from Jan 31 (at 12:00); Feb 5
- Extra Team Officials:
- Team Official are allowed to stay at the Athletes Hotel at their own expenses;
- The LOC has the right to change the hotel in case of over occupancy.

10. Insurance

All participants are requested to get their own travel and medical insurance.

11. Doping Control

Doping control shall be conducted under the IKA Anti-Doping Rules and following the World Anti-Doping Code under the supervision of the ITA International Testing Agency.

12. Medals and Awards

Gold, Silver and 2 (two) Bronze Medals will be awarded to the winners in each weight category, along with diplomas. As well as WSP Ranking Points.

13. Training Facility

The LOC will provide the required training facilities on January 31-01 Feb (information will be provided upon arrival). Reservation required.

14. Registration Deadlines

- A. The deadline for registration is 10 JANUARY
- B. The deadline to apply for visa (if needed) 10 JANUARY
- C. The deadline for arrival (fly ticket) is **20 JANUARY**

15. Visa

The OC will grant assistance to all delegations on Visa matters.
